Official Rules & Regulations

Tournament Dates: Thursday, August 1st through Sunday, August 4th. Entrants must register by 11:59 PM on 7/31. Each boat entered may only fish one of the four tournament days. Each entrant must text 973-943-8201 or email anglerpmh@aol.com, give their name and date they are fishing by 9 PM the night before the day they intend to fish. In the event no message is received, their designated fishing day will be Sunday, August 4th.

Fishing Hours: Dawn until there is sufficient time to make it to the weigh-in station before they close but no later than 5 PM on your designated fishing day. **(Some weigh-in stations may close before 5 PM)**

Fishing Location: Fish all waters within 20 miles of the New Jersey coast open to the public, including the ocean, bays, inlets and rivers stretching from the Raritan Bay & Hudson River in the north to Delaware Bay in the south.

Weigh-in Stations: Entrants must weigh in their fish at Atlantic B&T in Middletown, Bahr's Landing Marina in the Highlands, Fishermen's Den in Belmar, Captain Bill's Landing in Point Pleasant, Creekside Outfitters in Waretown, Fisherman's Headquarters in Ship Bottom, Great Bay Marina in Little Egg Township, Fin-atics in Ocean City, One Stop B&T in Atlantic City or Jim's B&T in Cape May by no later than 5 PM on their designated fishing day. Entrants should confirm that their choice of a weigh-in station will be open until 5PM. If not, be sure to get there before they close or go to another weigh-in station. Some weigh-in stations may close early or have restricted hours. Weights will be recorded by the weighmasters on the official tournament weigh-in sheets, but entrants should make certain that they receive a receipt or take a photo of the weigh-in sheet.

GENERAL RULES AND PROVISIONS:

- The tournament will be held rain or shine on August 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th. It is the sole responsibility of the entrant/captain of all entered boats to determine if weather and sea conditions are safe to fish. The Jersey Coast Anglers Association, its administrators, officers, directors, agents, committee members, sponsors and/or any and all other persons assume no responsibility or liability for any boats entered or individuals participating in the tournament.
- If weather conditions prohibit any or all boats from fishing and, as a result, an insufficient number of fish are weighed in to account for any of the prizes including Calcuttas, drawings will be held.
- It is the responsibility of all entrants and contestants to comply with all state and federal regulations including any applicable state registry requirements.
- Each boat may have up to 6 people onboard and no more than 6 lines may be in the water at one time.
- Each entrant may only win one prize but may win multiple Calcuttas
- All fish presented to the weighmaster will be recorded in pounds and hundredths of pounds. The time the fish are presented for weigh-in will be recorded in hours and minutes.
- If two fish tie by weight, the first fish weighed in will hold the position on the leader board. If two fish are the same weight and weighed at the same time, prizes will be split.
- JCAA reserves the right to require a polygraph examination within 60 days, at JCAA's expense, of any
 captain/entrant or crew member to preserve the integrity of the tournament. Failing the test or refusing
 to take the test will result in disqualification. Tests may be given to those suspected of breaking any rules
 as well as to repeat winners and/or those who win more than 5K.
- Names and likenesses of all prize winners may be used by JCAA and JCAA's designee(s) for promotional purposes without further compensation to JCAA or the individual prize winners.
- Any and all appeals must be made in writing and submitted to JCAA no later than 4 PM on 8/5/24 Appeals
 must be accompanied by a \$25 processing fee. If the appeal is granted, the money will be refunded. All
 decisions made by JCAA will be deemed final.
- Calcuttas: For the Calcuttas, you are competing against everyone in the tournament as there are not separate Calcuttas for each weigh-in station. JCAA will pay out 7/8 of the money collected to the winner of each Calcutta.
- All prize money including money from Calcuttas will be given via check to the registered entrant.
- There will be no Captains meeting or Awards Ceremony. Standings will be posted on our FB page

Dear Fellow Anglers,

JCAA has suspended its traditional fluke tournament, so the Heavy Hitters Fluke Tournament will be the only one we will be running this year. We are in transition, moving to a new office in Wall. We have additional expenses and there is much renovation work that needs to be done. We are trying to do much of the work by ourselves to save money, but we really need you to help by supporting this tournament as well as attending our Sportsperson of the Year Dinner on 11/10 and buying some of our Hi-Roller Raffle tickets.

The tournament format will be similar to last year, though we will not be having a 25 K doormat fluke category because it has become too costly, and it did not add enough entrants. We are going to use some of the money saved to up the prizes for those who catch the biggest fluke. Better still, the entrant who catches the largest fluke will win a brand new 9.9 H.P. engine donated by YAMAHA and \$2500 cash*. Second Place will be a custom rod valued at \$950 donated by Richard Hunzinger \$2000 cash*. Third Place will be \$1500 cash*.

*Cash prizes are based on 175 entrants and will be adjusted upwards or downwards based on the number of entrants.

The tournament will be run from 8/1-8/4. We realize that not everyone can fish two, three, or four days so to be fair to everyone, each boat will be limited to fishing only one day. However, each entrant will be able to choose the day they fish. We are hopeful that we will have nice weather on at least one of those days. As we did last year, prizes will be based on the weight of the single largest fluke. However, we will still have 1 fluke and 3 fluke Calcuttas for those who want to compete in that more skilled category. We will also have sea bass Calcuttas. JCAA has worked for recreational anglers on fishery and environmental issues in the past and will continue to do so in 2024 and beyond.
